Professor Shimp received a Bachelor of Science in Engineering from the US Naval Academy in 1976, Master of Science in Information Systems from the US Naval Postgraduate School in 1984, and PhD in Philosophy from Sofia University St. Kliment Ohridski in Bulgaria in 2010. He was awarded Doctor Honoris Causa by Caucasus University on 12 October 2011 for his extraordinary contributions in strengthening international relations and his exceptional record of public service to Georgia. He is a published authority on American and European Union governance and is a member of the Advisory Board of the World Security Network. He also serves as Honorary Consul of the Republic of Georgia.

A retired U.S. Naval officer and former Commander of the South Carolina Naval National Guard with the rank of Rear Admiral, Dr. Shimp now oversees a broad range of activities for Maybank Industries LLC, one of South Carolina's premier multi-mission maritime companies with extensive experience in global logistics, shipping and terminal operations, vessel construction, international project management, and intermodal security.

Rear Admiral Shimp received numerous US, UN, NATO, and other international military decorations during his distinguished naval career and was granted the Freedom of the City of London in 2003. He is Founder and President Emeritus of the Black Sea Council of the Navy League of the United States, a multi-national civilian organization that supports US and allied sea service personnel as well as maritime activities in this strategic region.
