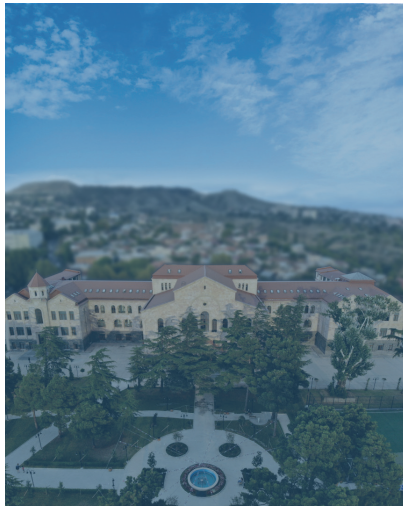

## COLLABORATION BETWEEN CAUCASUS UNIVERSITY AND NEW JERSEY CITY UNIVERSITY



Caucasus University and New Jersey City University have been collaborating since 2019, after signing an academic cooperation agreement. Under the agreement, a double degree undergraduate program in cybersecurity was developed.

### DOUBLE DEGREE CYBERSECURITY PROGRAM:

The Caucasus University and New Jersey City University (USA) double degree program is the first 3-year bachelor's program in cybersecurity in Georgia, upon completion of which the student will receive diplomas from the two universities.

The program awards the student a bachelor's degree in computer science from the Caucasus School of Technology and a bachelor's degree in cybersecurity from New Jersey City University (USA).

The 3-year undergraduate program involves studying in Georgia for the first 5 semesters with Georgian and foreign professors, and in the last, 6th semester, the student continues their studies in New Jersey, USA.

## CAUCASUS SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY:

The Caucasus School of Technology was founded in 2008. Its purpose is to train competitive specialists in line with the latest requirements of the field. The school is equipped with modern laboratories, studios, and spaces for practical work.

Since 2021, Caucasus School of Technology has been cooperating with BIT SENTINEL, the organizer of the large-scale European cybersecurity event "DefCamp". Based on this cooperation, Caucasus University and its partner, the Scientific CyberSecurity Association, have been empowered to hold international cybersecurity events—hackathons—in the Caucasus region.

As part of this collaboration, a CyberSecurity Center has been set up at the School of Technology to conduct ethical hacking courses using BIT SENTINEL and CyberEDU special virtual machines and software.



## NEW JERSEY CITY UNIVERSITY
