
1. Welcome to Winter School Lisbon

3. Course & Provisional Schedule


Cross Cultural Communication and Negotiation

Therefore, this programme learning goals are:


- To understand key influences of culture in human behaviour, in the work place and at the individual relationship level, and also in international setting;

Application Process



- Submit your application on Iscte's internal platform, Fénix +.
 - Consult the Application Guide here.
- You will receive a feedback from the programme manager within 5 working days.
 - If you, receive a positive feedback you should them proceed with the registration within 4 days.
 - The Registration Guide will be sent by the programme manager.
- Once you have successfully completed your registration, you will receive payment instructions within 5 working days:
 - Payment will be made through the system by credit card.
 - Payment should be made within 7 days.

Documents Requested

Application

- Identity Card:
 - Identification document with photo, name and number visible;
 - EU-citizens should attach Identification document from the country of origin or passport
 - Non EU-citizens should attach passport
- Photograph:
 - Passport-size colour photo with a light background.
- Curriculum Vitae
- Transcript of Records:
 - From the current degree you are attending
 - Either a scanned version of an official Transcript of Records or a print screen of your Home University personal student area
 - If you are a former student, upload your diploma/certificate of your most recent degree

Enrollment

- Insurance
 - Each participant must have personal accident and health insurance, including international emergency medical assistance. We strongly recommend that you take out **travel insurance**.



4. Applications & Fees

Fees, Payment & Cancellation Policy

1.000€ Students from Iscte partner universities

1.150€ Students from non-partner universities (outside Portugal)

The programme fee includes:

- Tuition;
- Course materials;
- Use of the library, PC labs and Iscte facilities;
- Public transportation card in Lisbon;
- Welcome Session and Farewell Ceremony,
- Transcript of Records or Certificate of attendance (in case the student does not complete the course with success).

Payment:

The tuition fee will be available in Fénix+, after the student enrolls. The payment is done through credit card within the specified deadline.

Cancellation Policy:

In case of dropping out after the payment has been done, we apply the following policy:

- Cancellation until the beginning of the course:
 200€ will be retained by Iscte
- Cancellation after the beginning of the course:
 no reimbursement.

Any bank fees charged within the reimbursement will be borne by the student.
