
Bijan Fazlollahi

Professor Emeritus Fazlollahi received his Honorary Doctorate from Caucasus University in 2009. He has earned a BS degree from MIT and MBA and Ph.D. degrees from Syracuse University.

Professor Emeritus Fazlollahi is a teacher and a researcher at the Robinson College of Business. He serves as the Director of Center for Business Development in Transitional Economics. He directs several U.S. Government and privately funded university partnership projects for the establishment of BBA, MBA, MS, and Ph.D. programs in Egypt, Azerbaijan, and Georgia. His latest grants are from the USAID for Ph.D. in Georgia and for BBA in Egypt.

He was awarded Honorary Citizen of Georgia in November 2004 by Presidential Decree. He also served as a Fulbright scholar in the former USSR. His research is in the field of Information Systems and Decision Support Systems.
