Admission and Registration Terms

Conference Status and General Info

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ Jean Monnet module “*Europeanization of Law Programs in Georgia*”, a national scientific conference “**Research the EU in favor of Georgia**” will be conducted.

Taking into account the goals and objectives of the module, the scientific reports (abstracts) presented at the conference should contribute to the Europeanization of Georgian laws, policy, practice and the generation/introduction of new knowledge about the EU into Georgian scientific and sectoral fields. <https://cu.edu.ge/en/grant-projects/ongoing-projects/zhan-mones-proekti/eu-lp-ge>

The Conference will take place on on June 12, 2025 (Thursday), at 10:00 a.m. in the Conference Hall of the Caucasus University (3rd floor); P. Saakadze 1, Tbilisi.

Requirements for the Conference reports/abstracts

Conference abstracts can be submitted by academic staff or students. Joint actions of a lecturer and a student are welcomed.

For registration, it is necessary to prepare an abstract within **1000-1500 words (without symbols)**.

The abstract must be prepared in Georgian and English; the report must be made in Georgian.

The abstract must include the author(s)'s name/surname, academic position/status, name of university, and email address.

The conference report should be prepared in the following areas:

- **Cultural diversity policy of the EU;**
- **Import of goods into the EU (custom union policy);**
- **EU Green Deal;**
- **EU Consumer Protection Policy;**
- **EU Labour and Employment Policy;**
- **EU Energy Policy;**
- **EU Competition Policy;**
- **EU Foreign and Security Policy;**
- **Artificial Intelligence, Technology and Innovation;**
- **EU Enlargement Policy (Enlargement Packages 2023, 2024 and 10 Countries);**
- **EU Migration and Asylum Policy;**
- **EU Trade policy;**
- **Functioning of the EU Internal Market;**
- **EU Budget.**
- **EU Social Policy;**
- **EU Economic Policy.**

Considering the above areas/fields, authors should present **a specific and narrow issue** (reflected in the title and abstract of the conference report);

The following should be incorporated into the abstract:

- a) Main research aspect, main question or thesis;*
- b) Purpose and subject of the research;*
- c) Novelty/relevance of the research (what/which new and specific knowledge is generated, which will bring new information for the Georgian scientific space; the report should not touch on a topic that has been researched/written about many times. It is fundamentally important to have novelty, and detailed information about the European Union);*
- d) The research should concern the law, policy, history, program, budget, action and/or practice of the European Union as a supranational union (a review/analysis of one specific case of the Court of Justice of the European Union is possible); or a comparative review of the enlargement countries in any narrow field (based on the EU Enlargement Pack 2023 and 2024 documents);*
- e) Reference to the scientific/research method and explanation of the need/application;*
- f) Review of sources (with a classified system, for example, normative material, scientific sources with references to authors, reports, decisions, resolutions or assessments of organizations/official entities; statistical information, etc.). It is important to confirm that the most recent and updated sources are cited.*

The abstract should be typed in Georgian and English using the **Sylfaen** font; Title font size – 12 (BOLD); Authors' name/surname, academic position/status, university and email below the title aligned to the right corner, font size - 10 italic; Abstract text aligned to both sides, font size - 12; Line spacing - 1; Paragraph spacing – 1.5. **The abstract should be prepared in Word format.**
