Lack of valuable, relevant standard-based research on the EU and the Europeanization of Georgia; at the same time, lack of literature in the Georgian language (for example, there is still no book EU Economic and Social Policy.


- Increase the financial scheme for Georgia or increase the quota so that there are more Erasmus+ programs in Georgia;

- Support to translations of books or elaboration of new textbooks in Georgian;
- Establish the mandatory teaching about the EU; advocate this issues at the Policy level.
- Launching broad-scale trainings for academia and scientists about the EU and Europeanisation dynamics of Georgia.
- Develop comparative studies and researches in all field of teaching related to the EU, EU-Georgia relations and Integration processes.
