## Doctoral Education Excellence Program

In today's rapidly evolving academic landscape, doctoral education must keep pace with cutting - edge technologies, robust quality standards, and global best practices. The Doctoral Education Excellence Program offers a unique, modular training initiative - developed under the prestigious CIF project (№CIF 2 2024 12) and supported by a consortium of leading Georgian universities (TSU, ATSU, CU) - to equip PhD candidates, academic staff, and doctoral supervisors with the necessary skills and insights to thrive on an international stage.

The call is open for TSU, ATSU and CU representatives only.

The program combines a set of courses. Each course is structured around interactive webinars, independent study, and practical exercises:

- Al for Learning and Research
- Supporting Doctoral Candidates' Professional Development
- Quality Assurance in Doctoral Education
- Mental Health Awareness and Wellbeing for PhD Students & Academics
- Internationalization of Doctoral Education
- Supervisors' Training

- How to run a doctoral school

This sequential approach ensures smooth progression in learning, enabling participants to build competencies progressively over a five - month period. Information regarding the start and end dates for each course will be announced gradually.
