From May 12–16, 2025, in Vilnius, Lithuania, within the framework of the administrative mobility of the Erasmus+ program, representative of the Caucasus University School of Medicine, Maka Amaghlobeli, and the representative of Student Services and Learning Process Monitoring, Lana Gogichashvili, participated in academic activities, as well as cultural and educational events organized by Vilnius University.
