Program Volume in Credits	
The Bachelor's Programme in English Philology comprises 180 ECTS credits: 60 ECTS credits per academic year and 30 ECTS credits per semester. Accordingly, the standard duration of the Bachelor's programme is three years. The academic year is organized according to the semester system. A semester consists of a set of teaching weeks, as well as the period allocated for additional examinations and the assessment of students' performance in those examinations. The academic year comprises the semesters and the vacation period between them. One ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours and includes both students' contact hours (lectures, seminars, practical classes, etc.) and independent study time (preparation for midterm and final assessments, as well as time allocated for completing assignments and preparing presentations). Upon the expiration of the standard duration of the Bachelor's Educational Programme in English Philology, a student with outstanding academic requirements is entitled to continue their studies for the purpose of completing the programme during additional semesters (not exceeding four semesters), while retaining student status. The Bachelor's Educational Programme in English Philology comprises a total of 180 ECTS credits, of which: • 140 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory courses within the major field of study; • 110 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory disciplinary and professional courses;	

- 30 ECTS credits are allocated to General and Professional English courses;
- 20 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory courses within the free component;
- 20 ECTS credits are allocated to elective courses, which students select from a pool of courses amounting to 80 ECTS credits offered by the programme (Note: the share of elective courses taken from the free component must not exceed 10 ECTS credits).

The programme предусматривает the delivery of certain courses in English. These courses are:

- English Phonetics I;
- English Phonetics II;
- English Grammar I;
- English Grammar II;
- Lexicology;
- Sociolinguistics;
- SLA (Second Language Acquisition Theory).

Program Admission Precondition

- A person possessing a full general education is entitled to study at the English Philology Programme.
- The precondition for the admission to the educational program is to pass the Unified National Examinations (it is required by the National Examinations to pass a foreign language examination - English language).
- In case of a student's willingness to transfer to the School of Social Sciences and Humanities of the Caucasus University from another higher education institution, the request is studied and the final decision is made in accordance with Georgian legislation. The Student is enrolled in the Caucasus University according to the order of the President of Caucasus University.
