The Bachelor's Programme in History comprises 180 ECTS credits, with 60 ECTS credits allocated per academic year and 30 ECTS credits per semester. Accordingly, the standard duration of the bachelor's programme is three academic years. The academic year is organized on a semester basis. One semester consists of 19 teaching weeks; therefore, the academic year comprises 38 teaching weeks. One ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of student workload, which includes both contact hours (lectures, seminars, practical classes, and other instructional activities) and independent study (including time allocated for preparing for midterm and final assessments, as well as completing assignments and preparing presentations). Upon the expiration of the standard duration of the Bachelor's Educational Programme in History, a student with outstanding academic requirements is entitled to continue studying for the purpose of completing the programme for up to four additional semesters while retaining student status. The Bachelor's Programme in History comprises 180 ECTS credits, distributed as follows: • 40 ECTS credits are allocated to Free Component courses. The Free Component consists of the	

following modules:

- General University Courses – 15 ECTS credits;
 - General English and English for Specific Purposes – 25 ECTS credits.
- 140 ECTS credits are allocated to courses within the Major Field of Study:
 - 115 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory courses, including 10 ECTS credits for the Bachelor's Thesis;
 - 25 ECTS credits are allocated to elective courses (Note: Students may complete no more than 10 ECTS credits of these as elective courses selected from the Free Component).
