The updated Bachelor's Educational Programme in Sociology comprises 180 ECTS credits, with 60 ECTS credits allocated per academic year and 30 ECTS credits per semester. Accordingly, the standard duration of the bachelor's programme is three years. The academic year is organised on a semester basis. One semester consists of 19 teaching weeks; therefore, the academic year comprises 38 teaching weeks. One ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of student workload, including both contact hours (lectures, seminars, practical classes, and other instructional activities) and independent study (including time allocated for preparing for midterm and final assessments, as well as completing assignments and preparing presentations). Upon the expiration of the standard duration of the Bachelor's Educational Programme in Sociology, a student with outstanding academic requirements is entitled to continue studying for the purpose of completing the programme for up to four additional semesters while retaining student status. The Bachelor's Educational Programme in Sociology comprises 180 ECTS credits. A total of 120 ECTS credits are allocated to courses within the Major Field of Study: • 95 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory major courses; • 25 ECTS credits are allocated to elective major courses. A total of 60 ECTS credits are allocated to the Free Component: • 25 ECTS credits are allocated to General University Courses and supporting courses for the major; • 25 ECTS credits are allocated to a foreign language (English); • 10 ECTS credits are allocated to general elective courses.	
Prerequisite to the Program	
➤ A person with high education has the right to study at the undergraduate educational program of sociology. ➤ The prerequisite for admission to the undergraduate educational program is passing the unified national exams. The conduct of unified national exams is ensured by a legal entity under public law - the National Center for Examinations. Exceptions to the general rule of enrollment in a higher educational institution will be allowed only in cases established by law.
