Academic program in ECTS	
The Bachelor's Educational Programme in Psychology comprises 180 ECTS credits, with 30 ECTS credits allocated per semester. Accordingly, the standard duration of the bachelor's programme for students of the School of Humanities and Social Sciences is three years. The academic year is organised on a semester basis. One semester consists of 19 teaching weeks; therefore, the academic year comprises 38 teaching weeks. One ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of student workload, including both contact hours (lectures, seminars, practical classes, and other instructional activities) and independent study (including time allocated for preparing for midterm and final assessments, as well as completing assignments and preparing presentations). The Bachelor's Educational Programme in Psychology comprises 180 ECTS credits, distributed as follows: • 135 ECTS credits are allocated to courses within the Major Field of Study: • 110 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory major courses; • 25 ECTS credits are allocated to elective major courses. • 45 ECTS credits are allocated to the Free Component: • 25 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory General University Courses; • 20 ECTS credits are allocated to General English (compulsory). • The programme allows students to complete up to 10 ECTS credits as free elective credits (FREE 0001.31, FREE 0002.31) by substituting elective credits from the Major Field of Study.	
Prerequisites to Program Admission	
➤ A person who possesses a full general education is entitled to study at the Psychology Program. ➤ The precondition for admission to the educational program is to pass the Unified National Examinations.	

- Passing the English Language as a foreign language exam in the Unified National Examinations is a mandatory requirement for enrollment.
- Prospective students eligible to the program without passing the Unified National Examinations must attest to English language B2 level of proficiency (IELTS-6.0; TOEFL-78; or other relevant international certificate confirming B2 level proficiency), or he/she has to pass a University administered English language B2 level exam.
- Mobility to the program is allowed following procedures set by the relevant law.
