The Bachelor's Educational Programme in Georgian Philology comprises 180 ECTS credits, with 60 ECTS credits allocated per academic year and 30 ECTS credits per semester. Accordingly, the standard duration of the bachelor's programme is three years. The academic year is organised on a semester basis. One semester consists of 19 teaching weeks; therefore, the academic year comprises 38 teaching weeks. One ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of student workload, including both contact hours (lectures, seminars, practical classes, and other instructional activities) and independent study (including time allocated for preparing for midterm and final assessments, as well as completing assignments and preparing presentations). Upon the expiration of the standard duration of the Bachelor's Educational Programme in Georgian Philology, a student with outstanding academic requirements is entitled to continue studying for the purpose of completing the programme for up to four additional semesters while retaining student status. The Bachelor's Educational Programme in Georgian Philology comprises 180 ECTS credits, distributed as follows: • 125 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory courses within the Major Field of Study; • 20 ECTS credits are allocated to elective courses within the Major Field of Study (students may complete up to 10 ECTS credits by selecting elective courses offered within the Free Component); • 35 ECTS credits are allocated to compulsory courses within the Free Component.	
Prerequisite to the Program	
➤ A person with full general education has the right to study at the undergraduate educational program of Georgian philology. ➤	

- The prerequisite for admission to the undergraduate educational program is the unified national exams. The conduct of unified national exams is ensured by a legal entity under public law - the National Center for Examinations. An exception to the general rule of enrollment in the higher educational institution will be allowed only in accordance with the law.
- English as a foreign language is required for national exams.
- It is possible to enroll in the program on a mobility basis in accordance with the law.
