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Since my school years, I have sincerely believed that I would one day have the opportunity to study abroad through an exchange program during my university years. This belief, together with the support of Caucasus University, gave me the chance to spend five months in a completely different environment, in another city and on a different campus.

This experience was incredibly important for my personal growth. I became more independent than I had ever been and managed to overcome my fear of adapting to an unfamiliar environment. Most importantly, I had the opportunity to explore new academic programs and learn from numerous internationally qualified lecturers who further strengthened my interests. Along the way, I also made friends who came to hold a special place in my heart.

Living on campus with other international students felt like being part of a family gathering, where you never had to feel alone. These relationships helped ease the sense of unfamiliarity and isolation that can come with being in a new environment.

The exchange program taught me that the boundaries between our abilities and our dreams are often created by our own fears. This experience gave me the confidence to discover more about myself, recognize new opportunities, and define my future goals more clearly.
