

Irakli Shamatava

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ academic staff mobility program, Irakli Shamatava, a professor at the School of Law of Caucasus University, visited Kazimierz Wielki University in Poland.

During the visit, he delivered a series of lectures focusing on the Georgian notarial system and its transformation from the post-Soviet period to the present day. In the context of comparative law, the experience of continental law countries was discussed, including the Latin-type notarial model.

The program created an important opportunity to become acquainted with modern research methods in the international academic space, particularly in terms of technological tools.

Alongside lectures and academic activities, Irakli Shamatava participated in discussions with professors and students. He also familiarized himself with the university's campuses, infrastructure, and library resources. As the editor-in-chief of a scientific journal, he found the university's periodicals and legal academic publications especially interesting.
