Assistant Professor at the Law School of Caucasus University, Givi Adamia, visited Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice, Slovakia, within the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme academic mobility from April 20–24.

As part of the mobility, Givi Adamia delivered a series of lectures on the topic: “Regulation of Energy Markets, Competition, and Legal Risks in the European Union.” The lectures covered important issues such as models of energy sector regulation, the role of competition law in liberalized energy markets, assessment of market power, and more.

Particular emphasis during the teaching process was placed on the discussion of practical examples and case studies, enabling students to deepen their knowledge of the functioning of EU energy markets and European competition law. The lectures were attended by undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral students, as well as academic staff.

Within the framework of the mobility, meetings were also held with faculty representatives, aiming to strengthen future academic and research cooperation, and to discuss prospects for developing joint programs and research projects.

The Erasmus+ Programme is one of the European Union’s key initiatives, promoting international cooperation in education, training, and research, as well as the mobility of academic staff and students and the sharing of knowledge among partner institutions.

This mobility represents another important step in the internationalization process of Caucasus University and in strengthening international academic networks.
