In May 2026, within the framework of the Erasmus+ academic mobility programme, Ms. Gvantsa Kheladze, Head of the Bachelor's Program in Architecture and Associate Professor at Caucasus University, visited the University of Alcalá in Spain.

During the visit, meetings were held with academic and administrative representatives of the School of Architecture. The discussions focused on existing and future opportunities for cooperation between the two universities. Participants exchanged information about their educational programmes, teaching approaches, and academic activities, laying an important foundation for strengthening institutional ties and expanding international collaboration.

A significant component of the mobility was participation in the EUGLOH Pedagogical Conference, where participants discussed contemporary challenges in higher education and innovative educational practices. Participants exchanged experiences in teaching, research, and educational management, while also discussing common challenges and potential solutions.

The visit contributed to the expansion of international academic networks, the exchange of professional experience, and the establishment of new partnerships. These outcomes will further strengthen Caucasus University's international cooperation and support future educational development initiatives.
