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From 29 June to 3 July, within the framework of the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility Programme, Sofiko Begashvili, Affiliated Assistant Professor at the School of Architecture and Design of Caucasus University, participated in the International Week hosted by the University of Technology and Arts in Applied Sciences in Warsaw, Poland.
