



Heitor Gurgulino de Souza



Prof. Heitor Gurgulino de Souza, born August 1 1928, is currently President of World Academy of Art and Science (WAAS) and President of World University Consortium (WUC). Prof. Souza has provided a significant contribution towards developing education worldwide, including South America, Asia and North America and received his Doctor Honoris Causa of Universities in the USA, México, Japan (2) and Brazil (4).

Prof. Souza has held a plethora of educational and managerial positions the world over and holds BS and Licenciado degrees in Math and Physics from Mackenzie University. His previously held positions include: Former Rector of United Nations University (UNU), in Tokyo, Japan (1987-1997); Special Adviser to the Director General of UNESCO in Paris, France (1998-1999); Vice-Rector of UNILEGIS - Federal Senate in Brasilia, Brazil (2000-2003); Member of the Federal Council of Education by Presidential Appointment (1974-1986); Former Rector of the Federal University of Sao Carlos (UFSCAR), State of São Paulo (1970-1974); Director of the Dept. of Higher Education at Ministry of Education in Brasilia (1972-1974); Director of the National Research Council (CNPq) of Brazil (1975-1982); Assistant Professor of Physics at the Aeronautical Institute of Technology (ITA), in São José dos Campos (1950-1957), Research Assistant at the Van de Graaf Laboratory, Department of Physics, at University of Kansas, USA (1956-1957), Professor of Physics Emeritus at UNESP in Rio Claro, State of São Paulo (1958-1999).

He is a Member of the American Physical Society, of the Brazilian Physics Society and of the Brazilian Society for the Advancement of Science and an Elected Member of the Brazilian Academy of Education. Prof. Souza is married to Lilian Maria and has two children – Carlos Eduardo and Gustavo Alberto.
