



Dr. Sergi Kapanadze is a Jean Monnet professor at Caucasus University. Currently, he is also the Vice Speaker of Parliament of Georgia. Along with his public service, Dr. Kapanadze has had a continuous academic career. He is the director of the PHD program at Caucasus University and a Jean Monnet Chair. He holds PHD in international Relations from Tbilisi State University (Georgia), Master in International Relations and European Studies from Central European University (Hungary) and completed an Executive Program in Negotiation and Mediation from Singapore Cooperation Center (Singapore).

He has a longstanding experience in public service at home and internationally. He has served as the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Georgia (2011-2012). As part of his DFM portfolio Mr. Kapanadze served as the Deputy Chief Negotiator from Georgia on the Association Agreement with the European Union. From 2015 – 2017 Dr. Kapanadze served as the Member of the OSCE's Panel of Eminent Persons for European Security as a Common Project.

For his special role and contributions to public service he received a Presidential Order of Excellence in 2011.
