





## Md. Sabur Khan

Dr. Md. Sabur Khan, a serial entrepreneur, Chairman of Daffodil International University (DIU) and Daffodil Education Network (DEN), started his business career in 1990 as a leading IT entrepreneur, naming Daffodil Computers Ltd., the 1st and one of the leading public listed IT companies in Bangladesh.

Dr. Khan has involved himself with many challenges as a President of Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (DCCI), the Bangladesh Computer Samity (BCS) and the Member of Prime Minister's ICT Task Force of the country. Being recognized as a 'Commercially Important Person' (CIP) by Bangladeshi government.

The commitment displayed has allowed Dr. Khan to be involved with universities worldwide, first as a Visiting Professor, then being awarded Honorary Professorship, Honorary Doctorate, Honorary D. Litt and Honorary Fellowship from universities like Said Business School and Oxford University by ABRM.

Furthermore, Dr. Md. Sabur Khan has been elected as the Second Vice President of Association of Universities of Asia and the Pacific (AUAP) and as the High-Commissioner of WBAF for Bangladesh by World Business Angels Investment Forum (WBAF).

Dr. Khan initiated a challenging project to create 2000 new entrepreneurs, written & published several books in two languages, and initiated business incubators, startups, venture capitals, Department of Entrepreneurship and 'Daffodil Foundation' at Daffodil Institute of Social Sciences (DISS) for the well-being of underprivileged people.
