¹ We can offer special activities on demand, with additional cost, such as one-day trips to Tequila, Tlaquepaque-Tonalá, or Chapala; as well as weekend visits to Mexico City, Puebla, Guanajuato, Querétaro and Puerto Vallarta.

² The program has a duration of 3 weeks, with the possibility of staying a 4th week. If you decide to stay the extra week, your 4th week with a single room and the 18 meals per week will already be covered by the original price.
