Archil Chochia is an Associate Professor at the Caucasus School of Law, Caucasus University, and the current Director of the School of Law at Tallinn University of Technology (TalTech). He obtained his doctoral degree from TalTech in 2013 and has also completed short-term study programs at the University of Scranton, the University of California, Pepperdine University, and Harvard University.

He is the author of more than 100 academic publications and the co-editor of the following books: *Russian Federation in the Global Knowledge Warfare: Influence Operations in Europe and Its Neighborhood* (Springer, 2021), *Brexit: History, Reasoning and Perspectives* (Springer, 2018), and *Political and Legal Perspectives of the EU Eastern Partnership Policy* (Springer, 2016).

Archil serves as the Editor-in-Chief of the *TalTech Journal of European Studies* (indexed in Scopus and Web of Science). His research interests include law and technology, the ethical aspects of digitalization, alternative dispute resolution, European Union integration, and the European Union's neighbourhood policy.

Archil Chochia is also a Senior Fellow at the Weinstein International Foundation. He has extensive experience in managing projects funded by various European programs, including Horizon 2020, Erasmus+, Europe for Citizens, and others.
