From 2010 to 2017, he pursued doctoral studies at the Faculty of Law of Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University, where he was awarded the degree of Doctor of Law in the field of Constitutional Law. The title of his dissertation was "*The Institution of the President in Georgia and in the Former Socialist Countries of Europe (A Comparative Analysis)*", under the supervision of Avtandil Demetrashvili.
