From 2006 to 2009, she pursued doctoral studies at the Faculty of Law of Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University and was awarded the academic degree of Doctor of Law in 2009.

She is actively engaged in academic and scholarly work at local public and private universities, as well as abroad, including in the United States (Columbia University, Duke University), Germany (University of Tübingen, Humboldt University, European University Viadrina), Italy (University of Campania "Luigi Vanvitelli," University of Salerno), and Portugal (University of Évora).

She is actively involved in scholarly activities, has published dozens of articles, participates in conferences and seminars, and conducts research.
