

### **Biography**

Levan Bezhashvili has 27 years of professional experience in the legal field. Over the past 20 years, his experience has included service in executive leadership positions, work within public institutions, and active involvement in the implementation of social, political, and institutional reforms. He also has experience in providing independent legal consultancy to international organizations.

From 1999 to 2023, Levan Bezhashvili served as Head of the Legal Department of the Parliament of Georgia. In 2003–2004, he held the position of Deputy Minister of Justice of Georgia. From 2004 to 2008, he was a Member of the 6th Convocation of the Parliament of Georgia. In 2008, he served as Governor of Kakheti. From 2008 to 2012, he was Chairman of the State Audit Office of Georgia (Chamber of Control). From 2016 to 2021, he held the position of Senior Legal Adviser at the International Development Law Organization (IDLO). From 2020 to 2022, he was a member of the Qualification Commission under the Prosecutor General of the Republic of Armenia, participating in the process of appointing the Chief Anti-Corruption Prosecutor and staffing the Prosecutor's Office. He also served as a Member of the 8th and 10th Convocations of the Parliament of Georgia in 2012–2016 and 2020–2024.

Since 2024, Levan Bezhashvili has been serving as an Associate Professor at Caucasus University.
