

Biography

Levan Mosakhlshvili has been affiliated with Caucasus University since 2007, where he initially served as a lecturer and was later appointed Head of the Undergraduate Program at the School of Law. His academic work encompasses legal education, research, and the development of educational programs.

In parallel, since 2013, Levan Mosakhlshvili has been working at JSC Georgian Energy Development Fund, where he currently holds the position of Deputy Director. Between 2019 and 2022, he served as Deputy Director for Legal Affairs, while from 2013 to 2019 he headed the Fund's Legal Department. During this period, he was also a member of the Board of Directors of LLC Kartli Wind Farm.

Prior to joining the Fund, Levan Mosakhlshvili was Head of the Legal Department at Georgian Industrial Group (GIG). Over the years, he has also served as Head of the Legal Service of Georgian International Energy Corporation, Manager of the Central Branch of Kordzadze Law Office, Coordinator of Court Administration for the Court Reform and Management Reform Project of Georgia, Deputy Director of the Civil Society Institute (CSI) and Director of its Public Administration Project, Head of the Legal Department of Constanta Bank, as well as Manager and Consultant at the Legal Aid Center of the Georgian Young Lawyers' Association.

Levan Mosakhlshvili is also EFIX's Energy Ambassador in Georgia and is actively involved in international initiatives related to energy policy and sustainable development.

He holds the academic degree of Doctor of Law and is currently a doctoral candidate in Energy and Electrical Engineering. He is the author and co-author of seven monographs, twenty-three scholarly articles, and fourteen studies, a significant part of which concern energy law, public administration, and regulatory issues.
