

## **Undergraduate Double Degree Program with Grenoble Ecole De Management, GEM, France**

The programme is meant for the Undergraduate students of Caucasus School of Business (All Specializations).

### **Program requirements**

Students enrolled at CSB can apply to this program, provided that they have completed two years of the CSB Bachelor of Business Administration program and have attained 120 ECTS credits.

### **Required documents**

- English language certificate equivalent to B2 level (TOEFL, IELTS or Cambridge Proficiency exam). The required scores are 94 Internet Based (with a minimum of 22 in each band) or 240 Computer Based TOEFL; 6.5 IELTS (with a minimum of 6 in each section), Cambridge Proficiency Exam (CPE): A,B,C; PTE: minimum 63
  - Minimum internship of 5 months or equivalent professional experience.
  - High school diploma and 2 years university transcripts.
  - Strong academic background (60% or higher overall average).
  - Updated CV in English.
  - Picture (3x4).
  - Scanned identity paper.
  - Two academic references.
  - 3 motivation essays in English (300 words each), to the following questions:
1. What would you like the GGSB admissions board to know about your professional work and / or academic experience?

2. Why are you interested in our particular program, and how do you see it helping you to reach your future goals?
3. What do you understand by culture shock? Have you ever experienced it and how did you deal with it?

### **Path to completion**

- To be awarded the GEM degree, students will need to complete all required modules of the third year of the GEM program (including a French language course) and obtain 60 ECTS credits.
- The other 180 ECTS out of those 240 is to be earned at Caucasus University during those three years of full time studies in Georgia.
- Upon successful completion students will receive a CSB Bachelor of Business Administration and GEM Dual Degree.

### **Application procedures**

- Meet with International Relations Manager at Caucasus University, International Relations and Projects Department, from Monday to Saturday.
- The Manager will assist you in understanding requirements particular to the above mentioned degree.

Deadline for submitting documents to Grenoble Ecole De Management is April 27.
